PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

It has been absolutely fantastic to see staff, students and all of our community enjoying returning to school! Particularly for staff and students who are reengaging face to face in the classroom. Everything has gone smoothly and it has been brilliant to see students getting back to their learning and social routines.

Thank you for the confidence you have shown in our health and safety planning, and the work that has gone in to ensuring a safe and stable environment for students to return. We are operating at a very cautious level and have organised hand sanitizers to be placed all over the school with extra cleaning sessions completed throughout the day. The other part is of course continuous reminders to students about their role, washing hands and keeping a good distance from each other.

In the first week or so of our return we have taken things very slowly. We want to get a feel of how students are on their return. We have run staff and student surveys to ascertain how our general well being is going. Students have been encouraged to seek support if they require it, or if they are anxious about being behind in their school work.

The overall feeling of staff, is that generally the students seem really upbeat and glad to be back at school. We have also checked our academic progress and have found we are in fact not too far behind, we are very confident we can make up this ground without putting any undue pressure on students. We will continue to monitor this and will make adjustments where and if required. You will be aware that already NZQA is delaying the end of year exams by 10 days, so again, this will make up some lost ground.

What has been fantastic is the student leadership, particularly in Chapel each morning. There have been many inspirational words spoken and reflections based on the bible and our faith. In the words of one student, 'we have had a small set back but will make a gigantic return'.

School sports are scheduled to get underway in mid-June and many teams have begun their preparation. Other school activities are also slowly coming back to life.

24/06/2020 - Senior boys football commences.

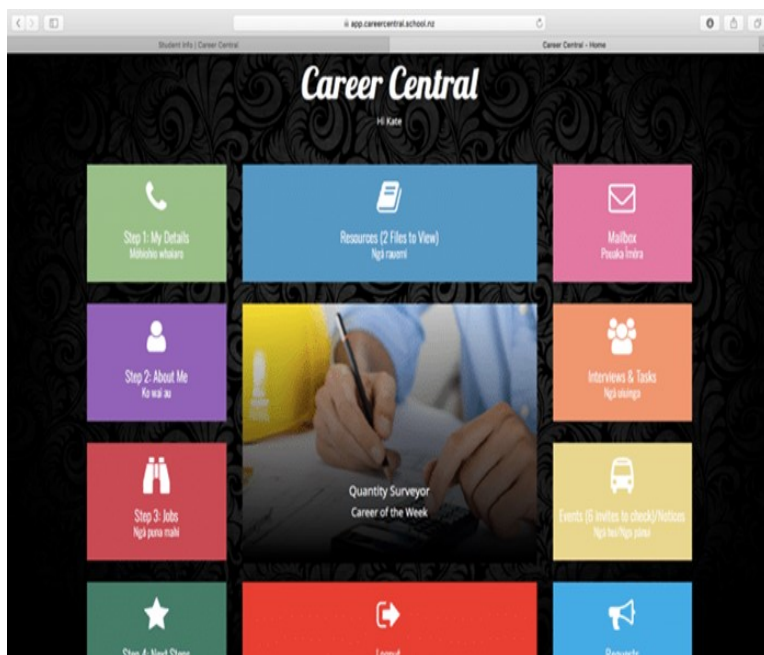
27/06/2020 - All rugby commences except for 1st XV and girl's rugby these dates are TBC. Netball start date. This date is yet to be confirmed.
