



HOSTEL STUDENT DISCIPLINARY POLICY

RATIONALE

Wesley College is committed to having disciplinary processes that are consistent with the principles of natural justice and the special character of the College.

POLICY

1. The Principal:
 - a. has the authority to stand down or exclude pupils from the hostel for any breaches of hostel rules or unacceptable behaviour;
 - b. has the sole discretion to decide what behaviour is unacceptable;
2. Prior to enrolment parent(s) / guardian (s) will sign a declaration acknowledging the Principal's authority and discretion.
3. The Board will approve hostel disciplinary procedures that specify the delegations made in relation to the implementation of these procedures.
4. The Board will establish a Discipline Committee to consider any appeal made in relation to the Principal's decision to suspend a boarder from the hostels.
5. The Discipline Committee's decision is final.
6. The Discipline Committee will report its decision to the Board.
