PRIORITY IN ENROLMENT POLICY

RATIONALE:

Wesley College will give priority of enrolment to students as per section 7 of the Wesley College integration agreement. The level of priority of such enrolment is outlined in this policy.

Preference of enrolment at Wesley College under Section 29 (1) of the Private School Conditional Integration Act shall only be given to those pupils whose parents have a particular sympathy with the special character which involves a close association with the Proprietor's hostel, or those parents who have a particular connection with the school and who as a result of their particular sympathy with the special character or their particular connection are willing to allow their children to board at the Proprietor's hostel.

Priorities

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

Preference Students

Preference students are students who reside in the Wesley College boarding hostel

The Wesley College integration agreement allows for up to 20% of the students of Wesley College to be non-preference students (These are day students)

Priority for Non-preference students

Priority 1	Siblings of present students.
Priority 2	Siblings or Children of past students.
Priority 3	Children of Presperters or employees of the Methodist Church.
Priority 4	Students who are the children of employees of Wesley College who are not covered by Priorities 1-3.
Priority 5	All other students.

The number of non-preference places is dependent on the number of preference applications accepted

Non-preference students can apply to reside in the Wesley College Hostel. Once accepted to the Hostel, these students become preference students.

Parents need to contact the school to find out how many places are available in a given year.
