## OTHER POINTS

- Coming Onsite: Parents/caregivers and non-essential personnel are asked not to be
  on site unless for a specific reason. If you are onsite, please wear a properly fitted
  facemask and follow signing in, QR scanning and distancing protocols.
- Facemasks: Students will be required to wear properly fitted face masks inside all school buildings.
- Morning Chapel: As you know Chapel every morning is the key part of our school life.
   While we cannot hold this inside, we have plans to hold open air Chapel several times a week.
- **School stationery** lists are available on the school website <a href="www.wesley.school.nz">www.wesley.school.nz</a> under the students tab.
- **Sick/Unwell:** Please contact the school immediately if your child(ren) is required to remain home from school as per public health orders or if they are **unwell**.
- If a student in the hostel becomes unwell, we cannot isolate students at school during the term of any infection. Therefore, arrangements will need to be made by you to pick them up as soon as possible. We will isolate them until you or an agreed family member arrives.

For students who normally reside outside of the Auckland area you may arrange for another family member to the school to collect your son/daughter if they become unwell. Please let us know who will be collecting your child.

For students who reside within the Auckland area please let us know as soon as possible if you cannot pick your child up and we will plan to ensure they are safely returned home.

We are hoping to ensure the start of year runs as smoothly as possible, and more importantly that all students enjoy a structured and positive return to school.

In terms of the first few days, this will look a little different this year as we are required to limit access to our site.

• Year 9 Camp: At this time, we are still planning for this event to go ahead. We will be the only school using the camp site at the time.
