Wesley College has a code of conduct that supports effective teaching and learning. Students are expected to be ready to learn, courteous and co-operative.

STUDENT CODE EXPECTATIONS

Students meet the expectations of Wesley College by:

- Being ready to learn
- Attending Chapel in the morning.
- Attending Form Period and all set classes.
- No use of cell phones during school hours.
- Only leaving class with an authorised note.
- Personal appearance meeting high expectations as per uniform procedure Pg7.
- Showing respect to college staff and fellow students.
- Respecting school property.
- Respecting other people's property.
- Remaining within school boundaries.
- Observing the Smoke Free nature of the school.

Consequences

- If a student fails to comply with the college rules then the following consequences will apply.
- Based on the different situations presented to us there will be matters that can be dealt with by the Learning Coach, Classroom teacher, HOD, Senior/Junior Dean and Deputy Principal. The Principal will manage the final stage of action after all prior avenues have been exhausted.
- The school will deal with situations as they arise either as a classroom issue or a school wide issue. These are explained in the next series of notes.
