## **DISCIPLINARY POLICY**

## **RATIONALE**

Wesley College is committed to having disciplinary processes that are consistent with the principles of natural justice and the special character of the College.

## **POLICY**

- 1. The Principal or delegated authority:
- a. has the authority to stand down or exclude pupils from the hostel for any breaches of hostel rules or unacceptable behaviour;
- b. has the sole discretion to decide what behaviour is unacceptable;
- 2. Prior to enrolment, parent(s) / guardian(s) will sign a declaration acknowledging the Principal's authority and discretion.
- 3. The Board will approve hostel disciplinary procedures that specify the delegations made in relation to the implementation of these procedures.
- 4. The Board will establish a Discipline Committee to consider any appeal made in relation to the Principal's decision to suspend a boarder from the hostels.
- 5. The Discipline Committee's decision is final.
- 6. The Discipline Committee will report its decision to the Board.
- 7. In regards to an appeal, the General Secretary will report the decision of the Board to parent(s) / guardian(s).
