Epworth Camp is a long-established Methodist campsite, set in beautiful surroundings on Lake Karapiro, Cambridge. Departure and return times

Meet at Wesley College:     **09:00** Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February prompt for a **09:30** departure.  
Return to school:           **14:30** Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February.

We shall be travelling to Epworth by coach. On arrival to College, children will make their way to the **Dining Room** to leave their baggage and register with their teachers. Children will wear mufti and can bring their favourite **healthy** snacks for the journey, with the usual school limitations (absolutely no nuts or seeds).

On return, children can be picked up from school after 14.30 on Wednesday.

**Accommodation:**

Children will be housed in dorm rooms which contain 6 to 8 bunk beds. Following consultation with other staff, children will be allocated to their rooms. There will be no changing or swopping of rooms, unless directed by the camp group leader

### Medication

If your child requires medication, please notify us on the consent form and hand all medication to the Group Leader for safe keeping on the morning of departure. Medication **MUST** be clearly labelled with the child's name and dosage instructions.

### Security, Safety and Discipline

Access to the activity centre is constantly and closely monitored. The bedroom areas are only accessible to Wesley College children and staff. Children will be supervised 24 hours a day by Wesley staff. Staff bedrooms are in close proximity to children's accommodation to maintain supervision.

Clear guidelines will be given to all children as to what is expected in regard to sensible, safe and considerate behaviour in the orientation meeting on arrival at camp.

In the unlikely event that a child behaves in a way that compromises the safety or well-being of themselves or the group, they will be required to leave the camp. In the unlikely event that this situation arises, Wesley College staff will telephone the parents of the child in question and parents will be expected to collect their child from the camp at the earliest possible opportunity.
