SMOKEFREE TANGATA BEATS (SFTB) Auckland Final will be held at Auckland Girls Grammar on 17th May, 5pm. Check in will start at 4pm. Session times and provisional running order are listed below.

Tickets for audience members are available at Eventfinda.co.nz, and will also be on sale at the door from 30min before the first act of the day. Prices for this event are \$20 for adults and \$10 for students (Teachers and children 5 years and under - no charge).

Regional Final Day

- Each solo/duo will play one song only (up to 4 min)
- Each band will play two songs (up to 7 minutes)
- Level 3 Music Performance assessment - If your heats performance is being filmed for this, you are allowed to perform two songs as a set. In this instance we will assess the first song only – just let us know at check in on the day of if you are doing this.
- There will be a prize giving held at the end of the regional final.
- Lyric award entries will need to be submitted prior to the start of the event. Forms are available through the resource section of your portal.

Cultural criteria

Your cultural criteria is important and what makes SFTB unique. You must feature AT LEAST ONE of the following elements for your song/performance.

- **LANGUAGE** - More than half of the lyrics to your song are in Te Reo Māori, and/or a Pacific language.
- **SOUND** - Showcase a traditional instrument from Aotearoa and the Pacific e.g. Taonga pūoro, drums, ukulele, conch etc.
- **ACTION** - enhance your performance with traditional movement, dance and/or action from Aotearoa and the Pacific e.g. haka, poi, siva, hula, bhangra, etc.
- **IDENTITY** - a use of topic and/or a style/flavour that reflects Māori and/or Pacific culture in Aotearoa.

Performance

- All songs must be original songs. For our purposes, an original song is a song written by one or more of the students listed on your entry form, and



you must have the right to perform/record/release any song you use. (Songs co-written by anyone not on your entry form are not eligible).

- All entrants must use the amps, drums, sound person, lighting person, and P.A. provided.
- You will need to bring your own guitars, basses, keyboards, keyboard stand and effect pedals.
- There is a ROLAND JUNO-DS76 keyboard provided on stage which you can use if you wish to.
- There will be 1 lead with each amp. You will only need extra leads if you use effect pedals.
- Guitar amps have foot-switchable distortion.
- There will be people to tune you up backstage and help you set up. If you are using elements of Electronic Assist, please prepare these for a quick and simple set up.
- Microphones will be disinfected between each act.
